



tropical cyclone Nalgae approaching the city. The No. 8 northwest gale or storm signal was issued at 1:40pm.

The Hong Kong Observatory issued the No. 8 typhoon warning this afternoon with

Nov 2, 2022 | 2:52pm Hong Kong time

This means that winds with mean speeds of 63 kilometers per hour or more are expected from the northwest quarter.

"At 6pm, tropical storm Nalgae was centered about 120 kilometers south-southeast of Hong Kong and is forecast to move northwest at about 10 kilometers per hour edging

closer to the vicinity of the Pearl River Estuary," said the city's meteorological agency. "According to the latest forecast, Nalgae will edge closer to Hong Kong tonight as compared with the previous forecast and will skirt within 100 kilometers of Hong Kong."

Under the influence of the rainbands associated with Nalgae, showers over the territory are expected to become more frequent gradually tonight.

Nalgae will weaken further. Whether the No. 8 gale or storm signal is maintained thereafter depends on the degree of weakening of Nalgae. If Nalgae weakens further into a tropical depression, the observatory will issue a lower tropical cyclone warning

The No. 8 gale or storm signal will remain in force before 10pm tonight.




